He first founded the Functional Food Center, Dallas, TX, in 1998. Since 1998, the US government has recognized Dr. Danik Martirosyan as an extraordinary scientist in the field of functional foods. From 2005-2010, Dr. Martirosyan was a

Clinical Professor at the Department of Nutrition and Food Sciences, Texas Woman's University. He continued to research as an Assistant Professor at University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, from 2011-2014. In 2015, he became the President of the Functional Food Institute at Dallas, TX, USA. Since 2010, he has been the Editor-in Chief of the Peer Reviewed, Open Access international Journal of [Functional Foods in Health Disease](#). Dr. Danik Martirosyan have published over 70 articles and 20 books. Furthermore, he has actively organized 20 International Functional Food conferences, in doing so, has created a global network of scientists, medical doctors, and food industry experts for modern functional food research and collaboration.
