



Garth Nicolson PhD, Conference Co-Chairman, Functional Foods and Diabetes Session Chair, received his PhD in Biochemistry and Cell Biology at the University of California, San Diego, in 1970. Dr. Nicolson is currently the President, Chief Scientific Officer, and Research Professor of Molecular Pathology at the Institute for Molecular Medicine. In addition, he has served as a Professor of Integrative Medicine at Capitol University of Integrative Medicine and as a Conjoint Professor at University of Newcastle, Australia, since 2003. Previously, he was the David Bruton Jr. Chair in Cancer Research and received the U.S. National Cancer Institute Outstanding Investigator Award. Furthermore, he was a professor and Chairman of the Department of Tumor Biology at the University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center, Houston and a professor of Internal Medicine and Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of Texas Medical School from 1980 to 1998. He is also an Honorary Colonel of the U. S. Army Special Forces and an Honorary U. S. Navy SEAL for his work on Armed Forces and veterans' illnesses. In addition, Dr. Nicolson has published over 600 medical and scientific papers, 16 books, and 9 patents.
